Rainforest Awakening

8.00am – 9.30am daily except Mondays

As morning light breaks the forest awakens to the sights and sounds of birds, monkeys, squirrels and a myriad of other delightful animals. Morning is the best time to walk our grounds to gain an insight into the thriving plant and animal life here. Discover a treasure trove of medicinal plants that are increasingly finding their way into modern medicine.

Rainforest Afterdark

Beach Walk- Living On The Edge

Learn about the ecosystems along the shoreline and discover how the many plants and animals have adapted to live in this dynamic environment of constant change, overcoming the daily challenges of the rise and fall of the tides, shifting sands, saline conditions and heat of the midday sun. NATURE EXCURSIONS

The island of Langkawi is a true ecological gem, the perfect combination of sea, sun, fascinating rainforests, mysterious mangroves, birds and wildlife. There are enough things to experience to excite the adventurous as well as the ardent naturalist in you. We've put together a variety of tours that will take you off the beaten track as you appreciate the beauty and fragility of nature. All activities adhere to strict ecological best practices standards.

Mangrove Cruise

10.00am – 2.00pm and 3.00pm – 7.00pm daily

The Kilim Karst Mangroves was the first site in Southeast Asia to be named a UNESCO Geopark. An insular mangrove forest coexists with magnificent fossil-rich, near-vertical to subrounded limestone hills dating back to over 400 million years. This once-arcanic coral is now home to a unique floristic group of plants, some of which cannot be found anywhere else in the world. Tunnel through caves and spot eagles, kites, kingfishers, mudskippers, fiddler crabs, monitor lizards and a variety of other fauna that thrive beneath and between the meandering towers of limestone.

Islands Geopark Cruise

Available daily on request - departing anytime between 8.00am and 3.00pm

Private arrangement: RM500 per boat for 2 persons and RM50 per additional person, price includes boat and transfers only.

Explore the southern archipelago by speed boat and visit Pulau Dayang Bunting (Pregnant Maiden Island), Pulau Beras Basah and Pulau Singa Besar. We meander through fjords and narrow channels between magnificent sea-stacks as we search for eagles, flying foxes, kites and kingfishers. We stop at a quiet beach for a lazy but welcomed swim and beachcombing.





NATURE ADVENTURES

With such a diversity of natural terrain to explore, whether through the dense rainforest or along the winding waterways, Langkawi offers a variety of activities that perfectly combine educational adventures with outdoor fun. All activities adhere to strict ecological best practices standards.

Kayaking & Swimming Adventure

10.00am – 2.00pm Wednesdays, Fridays & Sundays

*RM250 per adult RM150 per child, 3 persons up to a maximum of 12 persons

A short drive takes us to Kubang Badak River where we don our lifejackets and get straight into our kayak. We row with the flow of the tide along the tranquil mangrove forests and enjoy the birdlife and wildlife here. On returning to shore, another short drive brings us to the rainforest and we begin an easy 400 metre hike to a secluded stream where fresh waters cascade into a beautiful clear pool. Here we enjoy a dip in the cool refreshing waters and end this day with a delightful lunch.

Jungle Trekking

8.00am – 11.00am daily except Monday.

RM130 per adult, minimum 2 persons

For keen hikers, there are several jungle trails around the hotel of varying difficulty, catering to different levels of fitness. Trails can be custom designed to meet particular needs. Your guide will highlight the many medicinal plants found here and used in traditional Malay medicine. This tour is lead by the local medicine man.

Family Trekking

3.00pm – 6.00pm Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays

RM 200 per family, maximum 6 persons

For families with small children we offer a short and easy 500m trail that leads to a nearby jungle stream where they can have a fun swim, a welcome respite in the most natural of settings.

SPECIAL INTEREST TOURS

With over 20 years of experience our talented group of nature guides can take you to the best places and times for flora, fauna and scenic views. Whether your passion be reptiles, butterflies, birds, primates or other wildlife, meet up with us at the nature desk and allow us to custom design a tour that meets your particular interest.

Escorted Wildlife Photography Tours

RM450 per person, RM50 per additional person with maximum 8 persons.

For those who are passionate about photography, our guide will drive you to several spots around the island. Using his expert local knowledge we understand where to be and when to be there, putting you in prime place to capture wildlife and scenic views with your lens. We recommend this tour be done either early morning or late afternoon.

Birdwatching

RM200 per person, minimum 2 persons maximum 8 persons

Langkawi has a rich diversity of ecosystems and habitat types. This includes lowland broadleaf rainforest, mangrove forest, reed beds, rice paddies, orchards, scrublands and mudflats. This therefore ensures a correspondingly rich diversity in birdlife on the island.

There are over 220 species of birds recorded on the island with approximately 30 percent being migratory. All our tours start early for the best opportunities to observe them and to avoid the heat of the tropical sun. We adhere to the Birdlife International Guidelines for Best Practices on Bird Tourism for this tour.

Day Cruise

Cruise the waters surrounding the islands of Langkawi and spot a variety of wildlife before arriving at a private, secluded beach. Relax, swim, snorkel, kayak or trek through the jungle while our beach crew prepare a mouthwatering feast.

Sunset Cocktail Cruise

Private Charter
